If you experience a fever within one month of leaving Guinea, Liberia, Sierra Leone, or the Democratic Republic of the Conge, do NOT go to a medical facility or Student Health Care Center.* Stay in your home and contact the Student Health Care Center by e-mail or call the Public Health Department (Hokenjo). If you contact the Public Health Department, please also inform the Student Health Care Center by e-mail.

*Minimize contact with other people as much as possible.
