*To avoid crowding, please come at the time shown on your reservation (you can check in 5 minutes early).

2. Examination Items: Chest X-ray, height/weight

*You may eat as normal on the day of the examination.

*Please wear a thin, plain t-shirt for the chest x-ray. (Do not wear clothes with printed patterns, embroidery, metal parts, buttons, fasteners etc.) Please remove bras, bra tops, etc. before the X-ray. Do not wear jewelry such as necklaces etc. If you have items that you cannot remove for religious reasons, please contact us. If you have long hair, please wear it up so that it does not touch your neck or shoulders.

3. What to Bring:

- ① Medical Examination Form (See example on page 3.)
- ② Surgical Mask etc. (Please wear a mask to prevent COVID-19 infection.)
- ③ A device that can display your confirmation email, or printout of the email (if you did not receive the email, please inform the staff when asked to show it; you do not have to contact us about it in advance).

Please make a reservation for the Regular Medical Checkups on April 21 (Thu.)–22 (Fri.), or in May and undergo the examination then.
