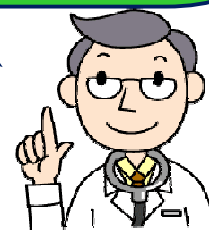


# REGULAR MEDICAL CHECKUPS FOR 2016
